Mobilize God's people

Alaska, Yukon Territory and Northwest Territories signal harsh climate, vast geography, small communities, and desperate spiritual needs. In this environment SEND places regional ministry teams to establish churches in hub communities with ministry reaching out to the surrounding villages. Radio, aviation, and bi-vocational missionaries play a key role in sharing the gospel in remote areas.

Engage the unreached

Outside religion has come to the North in a variety of forms and ways and mingled with traditional beliefs. The result is suspicion, confusion, and spiritual despair. Answers are hard to find when faced with the struggles of alcoholism and abuse that pervade many communities. SEND seeks to bring hope through the life-transforming power of the gospel.

Establish reproducing churches

In the next five years, SEND North and its partners will:

- Begin radio outreach in western Alaska and northern Canada.
- Establish two new regional ministry teams.
- Send more schoolteachers as bi-vocational missionaries.
- Continue to establish three hub community churches.

Pray for God to radiate his glory through transformed lives in the unreached villages of the North.
